

SUMMER VILLAGE OF MEWATHA BEACH

Bylaw 1/95

A Bylaw of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of establishing offices and other related matters under the Municipal Government Act, 1994, Chapter M-26-1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, Parts five (5) and six (6).

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, 1994, Chapter M-26.1 requires that certain actions in regard to organization of Council and Administration be taken by bylaw and/or resolution:

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Elected Official be appointed from among the Councillors and that this position be known as "Mayor";
2. That the Council appoint a Deputy Chief Elected Official to be known as "Deputy-Mayor", and that the remaining member of Council be the alternate to serve in the event that this is required. That in the absence of the Mayor, the Deputy-Mayor to assume the Mayor's responsibilities, and in the absence of both of them, the alternate to assume the Mayor's responsibilities;
3. That for the purposes of (1) and (2) above, that those Councillors serving in the appointed capacities designated, continue to serve in those capacities until after the next general election, to be held in 1995;
4. That the municipal office of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach be established at the place of residence of the serving Chief Administrative Officer;
5. That the position of Chief Administrative Officer is hereby established to be known as "Administrator", to carry out the powers, duties and functions of this position, as contained in the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1 of the R.S.A. That the appointment in Bylaw 61/88 be confirmed, and that employment be by way of an employer/employee relationship;
6. That the position of Designated Officer is hereby established to be known as the "Development Officer" for purposes of the landuse bylaw and any related legislation only;
7. That this bylaw shall have effect from the 1st day of January, A.D. 1995.

Read a 2nd time this 20th day of May, A.D. 1995.

Read a 3rd time this 20th day of May, A.D. 1995, with unanimous consent of council and finally passed.
