Please be reminded that Golf Carts are not permitted on public roads and if caught you could be fined. Please be respectful to the neighborhood.

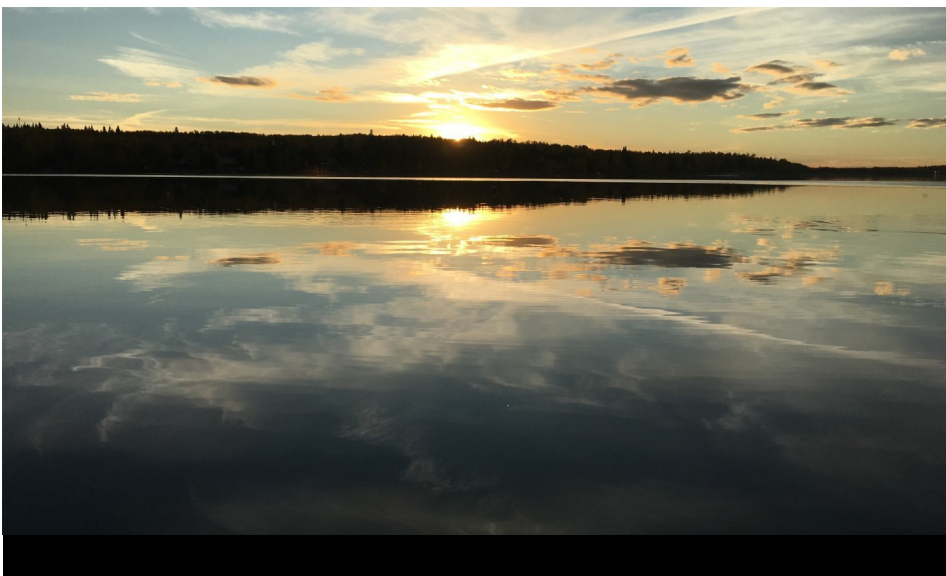
Dogs

Fire Bans

Fire Status

It is important to check the status of fire bans at the entrances of the summer village before lighting a fire. You can also check the status at www.albertafirebans.ca. If you go to the fireban website and type in Mewatha Beach you can sign up to get notifications every time the status changes. It is important that Fireworks are not lit within the Village during a Fire Ban.
